99% of UWL 2022-23 graduates were employed, continuing or planning to continue their education, or serving in the military or a service program within first six months of graduation. Data is based on a knowledge rate of 74% from all sources including First Destination Survey responses, National Student Clearinghouse data, and web based searches. Results indicate that 1% were still seeking employment; all but 1 respondents were seeking either work or education. Approximately 68% of graduates were working or studying in Wisconsin as determined by location of employer or graduate school. A total of 2180 Bachelor's and Associate Degrees were earned (total student count of 1,998), data was reported or found for 1610 of the degrees (74%), leaving 26% of the degrees without any information (representing 525 students).
