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What is the College Core?

College of Arts, Social Sciences, & Humanities and School of Visual and Performing Arts Core

The College Core provides opportunities for students to deepen their competencies in the arts, humanities, social sciences, and/or sciences beyond the requirements of general education. Students may select from courses offered by the full range of academic departments within the College according to their interests. The core allows students to build their critical thinking, communication, problem solving, teamwork, and global competencies through in-depth exploration of topics of their choosing.

1. Choose a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Science

English (writing and rhetoric or literary and cultural studies emphases) and majors in the Department of Global Cultures and Languages must earn a Bachelor of Arts degree. Education majors earn a Bachelor of Science degree.

2. Complete a CASSH/VPA designated diversity course

3. Complete a minor, second major, or CASSH/VPA Individualized Minor

*Must be on the approved CASSH/VPA Course List and from **outside** your major department. Courses can overlap with your minor or second major, but not general education (except for language).

CASSH/VPA Individualized Minor Option

Complete 18 credits in two or more departments or programs (at least 12 credits earned at the 300/400 level). These courses can be from any college but must be outside your major department.
