

GMAT/ GRE Waiver Policy

The GMAT / GRE admission requirement will be waived if the applicant satisfies one of the following:

- Undergraduate degree in a business field with a GPA greater than or equal to 3.25 (on a 0-4 scale) from one of the following:
 - A regionally accredited program in the United States
 - An AACSB or EQUIS accredited program anywhere in the world
- Successful completion of at least one year of graduate coursework in a UWL CBA affiliate program.
- Five years of full time professional experience that includes at least two years in a management or supervisory position.
- One of the following professional certifications:
 - Bar admission to practice law in any U.S. state
 - CFA, Certified Financial Analyst
 - CFP®, CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNER™
 - CIA, Certified Internal Auditor
 - CIRM, Certified in Resource Management
 - CLU, Chartered Life Underwriter
 - CMA, Certified Management Accountant
 - CPA, Certified Public Accountant
 - CPCU, Chartered Property Casualty Underwriter
 - CPIM, Certified in Production and Inventory Management
 - CPM, Certified Purchasing Manager
 - CPSM, Certified Professional in Supply Management
 - CQA, Certified Quality Auditor
 - CSCP, Certified Supply Chain Professional
 - Financial Licensures Series 7 and 24, and either 63 or 66
 - Member, Society of Actuaries
 - PE, Professional Engineer (test certification only)
 - PgMP, Program Management Professional
 - PMP, Project Management Professional
 - QPA, Qualified Pension Administrator
