REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

- □ Fulfill the University's General Education Program requirements.
- Earn a minimum of 120 semester credits with at least a 2.00 cumulative grade point average (GPA) Note that GPA requirements for some programs may be higher than 2.00.
- □ At least 40 credits must be earned in 300 and 400 (upper division) numbered courses.
- Earn a minimum of 30 credits at UWL.
- Complete CBA core requirements, and department major and minor requirements with at least a 2.00 cumulative grade point average in the business core and the business major (Accountancy requires minimum 2.50 major gpa).
- Complete at least 50% of the business course requirements (core and major) at UWL.
- □ Submit "Intent to Graduate" in WINGS.
