We assist students in all aspects of their job search from exploration to career decision-making, from critiquing documents to mock interviews, from internships to full-time jobs, and navigating job offers.

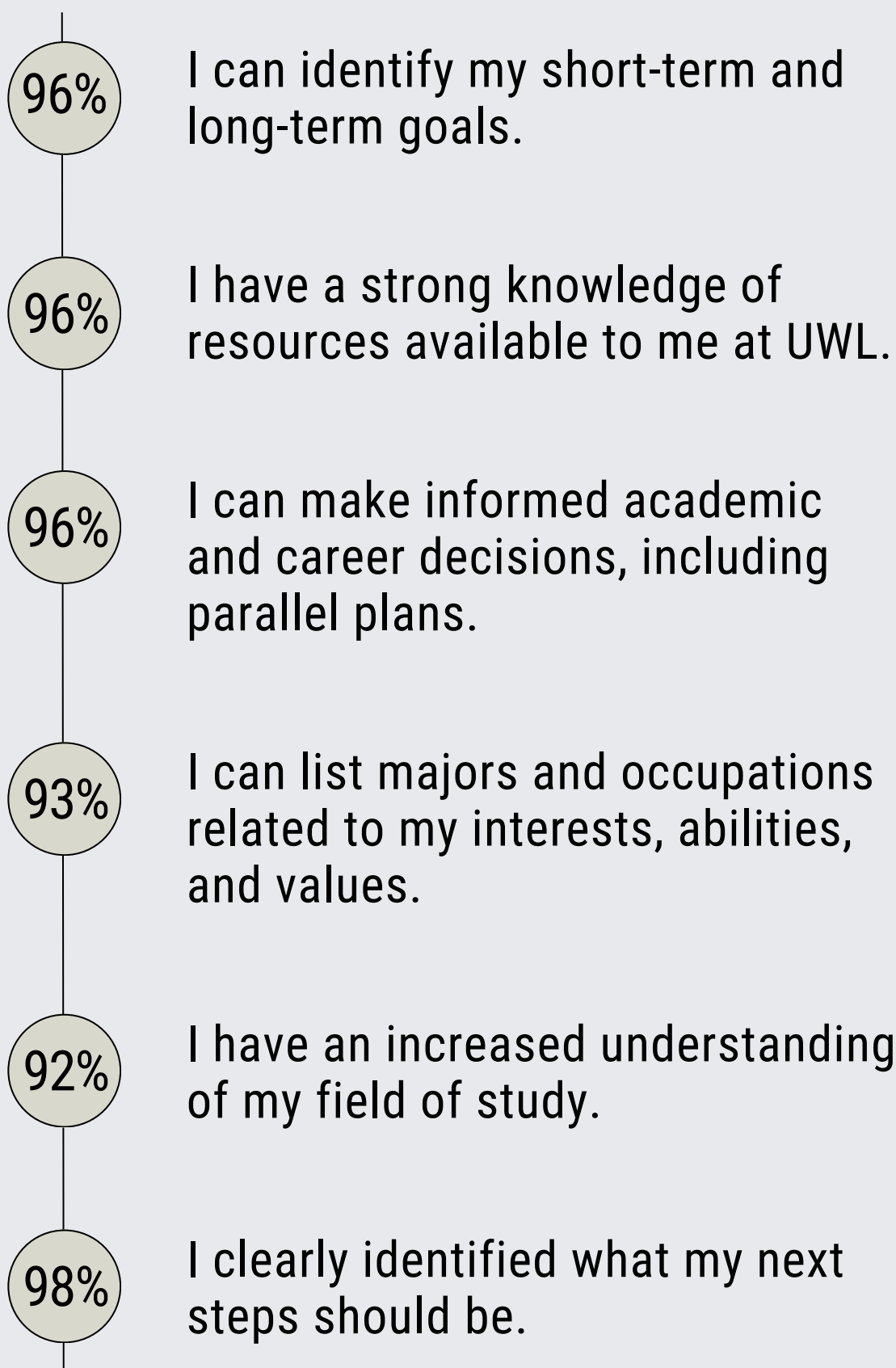


**PRE-HEALTH

ACADEMIC ADVISING

UNDECLARED ADVISING

Undeclared students in the College of Arts, Social Sciences, and Humanities (CASSH), the College of Business Administration (CBA), and the College of Science and Health (CSH) are served by the Academic Advising Center.

DROP-IN ADVISING

The Academic Advising Center provides drop-in advising for all UWL students during course registration.

FIRST-YEAR ADVISING

First-year advising for Biology, Communication Studies, Exercise and Sport Science, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Race, Gender, and Sexuality Studies departments is done by the Academic Advising Center.
