ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-LA CROSSE

AND

Northcentral Technical College

This Agreement is entered into between **Northcentral Technical College** (hereinafter sending institution) and the **University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, La Crosse, WI** (hereinafter receiving institution). This updated Agreement, and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the guidelines set forth in the University of Wisconsin System Academic Information Series (ACIS) policy 6.2 Guidelines for Articulation Agreements between UW System Institutions and WTCS Districts as well as policy 6.0 Undergraduate Transfer Policy. Both institutions agree to maintain accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission and any other accreditation currently in existence pertaining to degree programs articulated via the transfer agreement.

The sending institution has established an Associate of Arts/Associate of Science Degree (hereinafter sending degree) and the receiving institution has established a Bachelor of Arts Degree (hereinafter receiving degree) and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one degree to another. It is mutually agreed:

I. Admission and Graduation Requirements

- A. The receiving institutions admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and students who transfer under this agreement. Admission to UW-LA CROSSE does not guarantee admission to a specific academic major or program. Visit <u>https://www.uwlax.edu/admissions/apply/transfer-student/</u> for program admission requirements. This agreement does not guarantee bachelor's degree completion within four years.
- B. The University of Wisconsin System Undergraduate Transfer Policy (June 2011) states that students may generally transfer up to 72 credits earned at non-baccalaureate institutions. UW institutions may accept additional credits towards the degree where appropriate. This does not alter policies concerning credits to be earned in residence at an institution. A minimum of 32 credits must be earned from UW-La Crosse to receive a degree from UW-La Crosse.
- C. Students must complete the entire sending program and meet the receiving institution's admission requirements for this agreement to apply.

II. Transfer of Credits

- A. Qualified NORTHCENTRAL Technical College students will be guaranteed admission to UW-LA CROSSE as a transfer student at Junior status after fulfilling the specified requirements:
 - 1. Enroll at NORTHCENTRAL Technical College in the University Transfer Liberal Arts Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) program.
 - 2. Email your advisor and complete the Release of Student Records provided by NORTHCENTRAL Technical College.
 - 3. Complete the credits needed for junior standing (i.e., not remedial) at NORTHCENTRAL Technical College or complete the University Transfer Liberal Arts AA or AS degree.
 - 4. Meet with a transfer program advisor at NORTHCENTRAL Technical College at least once per semester while enrolled.
 - 5. Earn a minimum 2.25 Cumulative GPA and a minimum 2.0 GPA the term prior to transfer to the University Liberal Arts AA or AS program.
 - 6. Meet minimum requirements for transfer admission to UW-LA CROSSE. Visit <u>https://www.uwlax.edu/admissions/apply/transfer-student/</u>for current requirements.
 - 7. Apply online for transfer admission to UW-LA CROSSE at <u>apply.wisconsin.edu</u> Submit your application in the term prior to your proposed start date. A completed application with all required materials is due at least five days prior to the start of classes.
 - 8. Students suspended from NORTHCENTRAL Technical College for disciplinary reasons are ineligible to participate in the transfer agreement.
- B. Students who have completed the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree at NORTHCENTRAL Technical College will be considered as having satisfied the UW-LA CROSSE General Education Program, with the following caveat:
 - 1. Students admitted with an earned Associate degree are still required to meet all core, professional, ethnic studies, prerequisite, major and minor requirements.

III. Implementation and Review

- A. The Provost, Dean, or designees of the parties to this updated agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure, and guidelines conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 06/01/2024 and shall remain in effect until the end date of 05/31/2029 or for five years, whichever comes first, unless terminated or amended by either party within 90 days prior written notice.

- C. The college or university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to either degree occur while the agreement is in effect.
- D. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning 11/30/2028 (within six months of the end date).
- E. When a student enrolls at the receiving institution following this agreement, the receiving institution will encode any course waivers and substitutions.
