

What to do next?

- You may have to accept e-consent or address prompts before seeing your offer.
- Accept or decline your financial aid offer via your WINGS Student Center.
 - The amount accepted will be disbursed in two parts (Fall & Spring).
 - "Your Other Loan Eligibility*" is for information only and can't be accepted. See "Other Financial Options" below for more information.
- If you are offered Federal Work-Study, you will be emailed a link to a questionnaire which will help us find a work placement for you on campus.
- If you are accepting your first Federal Direct Loan, you will need to complete Entrance Loan Counseling and a Master Promissory Note. Both can be completed at studentaid.gov.
- If you wish for the Financial Aid Office to be able to discuss your information with your parents or others, you will need to set up a FERPA SECURE PIN at uwla.edu/records/ferpa.
- If you are receiving scholarships, be sure to report those awards in WINGS. Scholarship checks can be sent to the Cashier's Office.
- Refunds can be deposited directly into your personal bank account. Set up your refund preference in the Finances section of your UWL WINGS Student Center, choose 'Student Choice Refund'.

Disbursement of Financial Aid

All financial aid (except Federal Work-Study) is electronically credited to your university bill, generally on the first day of each semester if all documents have been completed.

Additional Requirements
