




With a gift of \$50, Murphy Library will place a commemorative bookplate in a newly-purchased book in a broad subject area of the donor's choice.

Here are just a few of the many projects made possible through the Murphy Library Endowment Fund.





Eagleopoly--How much do you know about UWL?

With your donations, the Murphy Library Endowment funded the printing costs for three Eagleopoly board games that were created as a part of Associate Professor Teri Holford's First-Year-Seminar course. This board game resembles traditional Monopoly with an Eagle twist! In creating this game, students brainstormed and selected questions related to UWL, voted on the type and value of the properties that would be sold during the game, and assigned player roles including chancellor, provost, registrar, campus housing, cashier or student senators. Holford recounted that "...students were proud to have been part of seeing this semester project become a board game that will live on and help other first year students adapt to college." These games are now available for check out at Murphy Library, for an entire class to play or individual students wanting to learn about UWL resources.

Special Collections--Preserving history

As you probably already know, Special Collections is a major resource for those researching UWL, La Crosse, the region, and beyond, with its vast collections of photographs, original documents, and rare books. But did you realize there are items contained in the collection with more of a national historical reach? Some might even argue, national significance. Are you intrigued? Without giving too much away, the Endowment Fund has enabled Murphy Library to take measures to safeguard some very important items through conservation efforts that are currently underway.
